Sermon Title: Empowered Discipleship: Stewardship


Scripture: Matthew 25:14-30



WEEDERT WANTED!

Did you ever stop to think about what you might be able to do with little or no effort to help out the church? Well, we have just the thing for you!

You would be responsible for the weeding starting September 1 of this year and going through the end of October. This would be a trial plan, but if it works out well then people will be asked to volunteer again next year.




