That is why He prayed in His High Priestly Prayer in John 17:20-23, "I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word, that **they may all be one**, just as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You have sent Me. The glory that You have given Me I have given to them, that **they may be one even as We are one**, I in them and You in Me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that You sent me and loved them even as You loved me." 
